






Example 4. Transposition of Musical Image 1 by minor third

Example 6. Musical Image 3 (piano) – Quiet Raindrops






Example 7. Interaction of Musical Images 1, 2, and 3


Example 8. Reduction of Music Images 1 and 2 showing gradual expansion of time span for each appearance of Music Image 2










Example 10. Ascending motions












Example 11. Outline of general ascent in Sections A and B
